1. Arising from the previous meeting

- (c) Magnolia House PPG - Peter B. has re-established contact with their Chairman and Secretary.

2. Newsletter

The PPG congratulated Peter B. for producing a very satisfactory draft and respectfully offered suggestions for minor improvements. Peter would circulate a second draft, probably by early next week. **Action: Peter B.**

3. Karen Maskell would attend the next meeting to discuss issues relating to interactions between the CCG and the Practice, including how the KCS Patients' Questionnaire might be used by the CCG (or not) and how it could or could not be compared with those circulated by other Practices who used different questions. Christine would remind her of the meeting and issues for discussion. **Action: Christine**

4. Other Business

The need for a new Secretary would be discussed at the next meeting. Developers at Lynwood were seeking planning permission to build a new health centre (possibly incorporating Magnolia House surgery). This might impact on the KCS, but might also provide useful additional facilities. It would conflict with a locally agreed strategic principle that existing green spaces should be retained to maintain separation between communities (in this case Sunninghill and Sunningdale). Peter B. would send the planning application number to CCG members to inspect if they wish. **Action: Peter B.**
